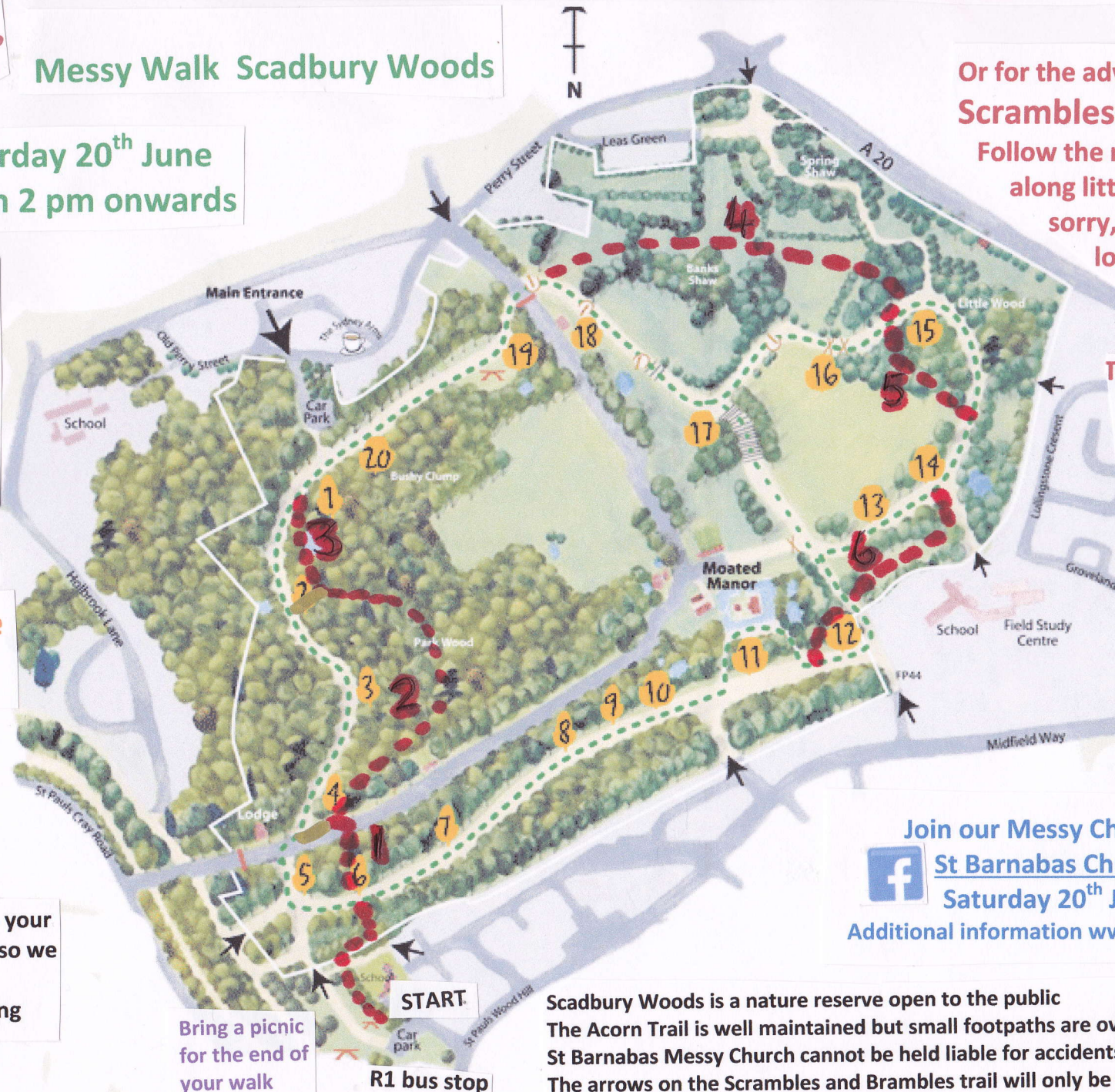
Follow the Acorn Trail –
