

Risk assessment (Coronavirus)

All staff members are responsible for following this risk assessment

- ❖ Parents/carers are asked not to bring their child/ren in if the child or any member of the household are showing symptoms of covid 19.
- ❖ These include:
 1. High temperature.
 2. New, continuous cough.
 3. Loss of smell or taste.
- ❖ Only one parent/carer can bring the child/ren to pre-school.
- ❖ Parents/carers will not be allowed into the hall. All children will be taken from the front door.
- ❖ If your child requires settling you will be allowed into the garden for this purpose.
- ❖ Parents/carers will observe the social distancing rule whilst waiting.
- ❖ Children will wash their hands when arriving at pre-school and regularly throughout the morning.
- ❖ We will be using the garden all morning where possible and the windows in the hall will be opened for ventilation.
- ❖ Staff will try and maintain social distancing but children are not expected to do this.

- ❖ We will only be using the girls toilets throughout the morning.
- ❖ Staff members will carry small spray bottles of disinfectant at all times so that they can clean as they go.
- ❖ Resources will be soaked in sterilising fluid after use.
- ❖ Children will be provided with individual pencils, pens, glue, paper etc so they are not sharing resources.
- ❖ An isolation area will be allocated for any child showing symptoms and PPE will be worn by the member of staff caring for that child whilst waiting for parent/carer to arrive.

PPE will include gloves, apron face mask and face shield

- ❖ Face masks will not be worn by staff members during the morning.
- ❖ Pre-school will have a maximum of 16 children per session in order to maintain a safe ‘bubble’.
- ❖ Staff members will ensure extra cleaning of all exposed surfaces and things such as handles, toilet flushes and chairs.
